- What about the focus and DoF?

4. Photographic Development

Why is this photo meaningful to you?

What does it show about your development as a photographer?

5. Peer Critique

Share this document with a friend. Have them take five minutes to answer the questions In #3 about your image. Remember, this is not an opinion so stick to what is seen. It should not sound positive or negative--just include the facts.
